Subject: Disability-Related Non-Discrimination Policy for AE/FA

Effective: PY04 - 12/13/2004

POLICY:

The Workforce Connection of Central New Mexico (WCCNM) Workforce Investment Board as a recipient of Workforce Investment Act (WIA) funding does not discriminate based on disability under Section 188 of Workforce Investment Act (WIA) (29 CFR Part 37), Title I and II of the Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.

WCCNM complies with these laws and regulations and takes appropriate steps, including assuring integrated services, non-discriminatory service criteria, provision of reasonable accommodations and effective communication, and effective service outreach to persons with disabilities, to ensure that it is providing universal access for people with disabilities to its WIA Title I-financially assisted programs and activities.
