Apprenticeship is a full-time paid job. Apprentices start at a percentage of their mentor's wage with guaranteed pay increases as they progress through the program.



Apprentices are provided in-person and online classroom instruction on the critical aspects of their occupation.



Apprentices receive on-the-job training under the guidance of an experienced mentor to prepare for a successful career in their chosen field.



Apprentices earn a portable nationally recognized credential within their industry when they complete the program.
